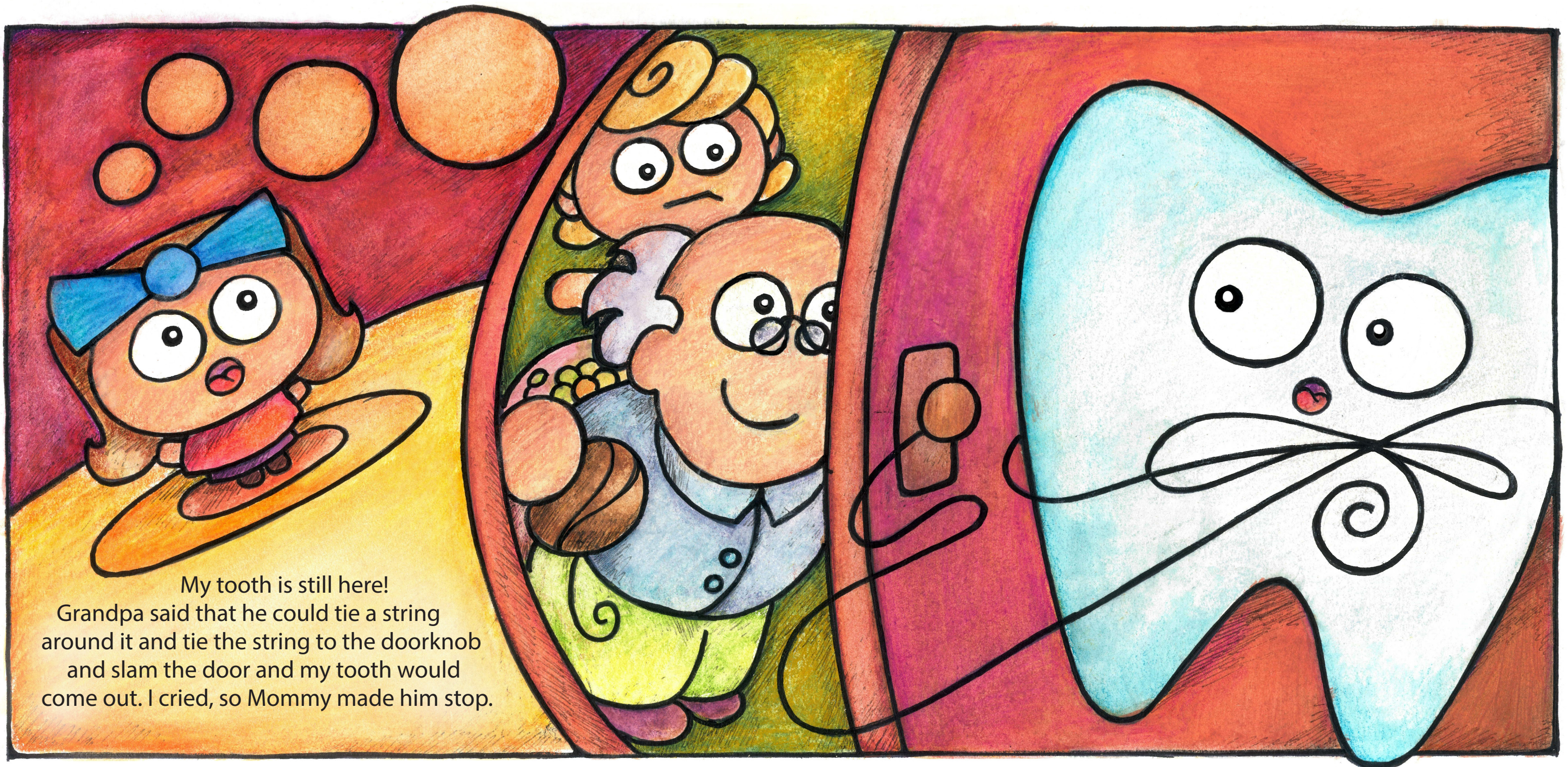




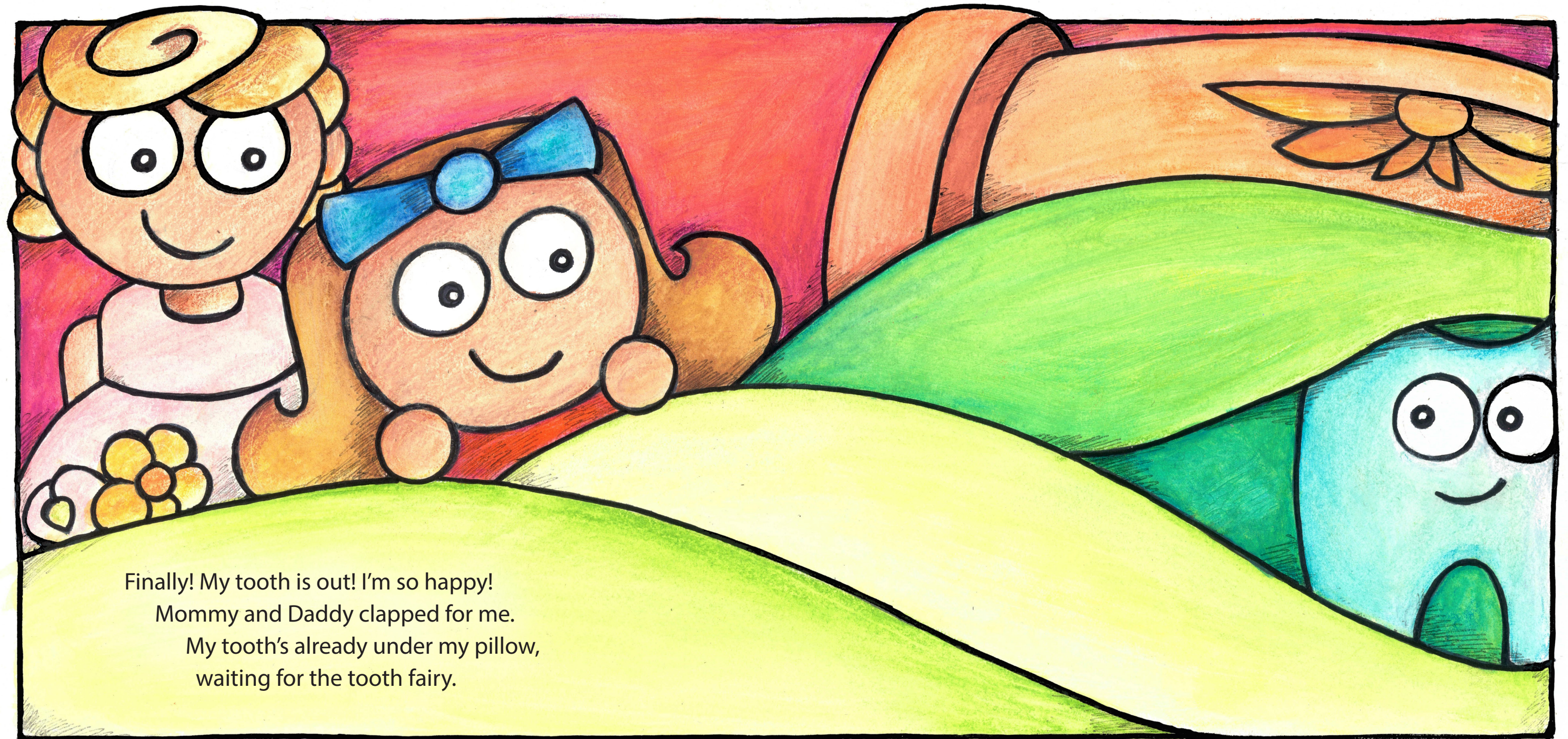
My name is Kayla. I'm seven and I have a very loose tooth.

when I take her picture.



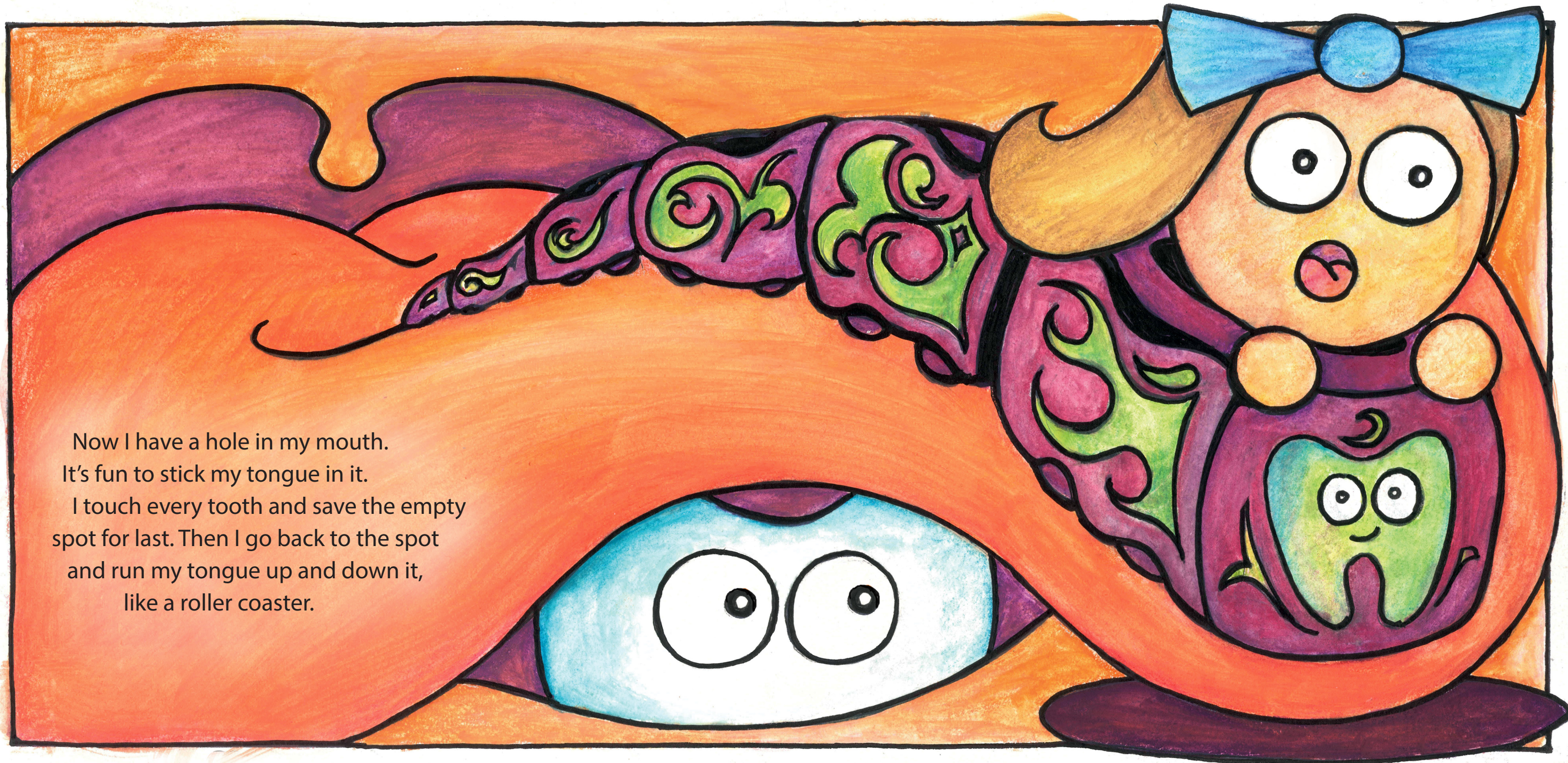



My tooth is still here!

come out. I cried, so Mommy made him stop.




Finally! My tooth is out! I'm so happy!
